### HOW LONG IS SESSION 3 (NOVEMBER) 2020 AND MUIC T6 2020? WHAT ARE THE KEY DATES?

#### CAN I COMMENCE S3, 2020 OR MUIC T6 2020 ONLINE IN MY HOME COUNTRY?

Yes. All units for Session 3, 2020 and T6 2020 will be taught online. By studying online, you will experience a high quality of education with the same Academics as those on-campus. You will receive a transcript for units completed online prior to your course commencing on campus. This way you can maintain the progress of your study and career goals.

If you are an onshore student, subject to timetabling, there may be some face-to-face classes made available.

### IF I COMMENCE MY STUDIES ONLINE, CAN I STILL COME ON CAMPUS?

Yes. What makes studying at Macquarie great is the flexibility to do it from anywhere in the world.

While you may start your study online in your home country, if travel restrictions are lifted during the Session and you can travel, you will be able to come to Australia and continue your studies here.

Subject to Australian Government advice, Macquarie is planning a phased return to on-campus teaching. This means that teaching may remain online or be a mix of both virtual and face-to-face activities, keeping within social distancing requirements as we move towards a full return to on-campus teaching.

Otherwise, if you are already onshore in Sydney, Australia, you are welcome to come on campus if there are face-to-face classes/ workshops available and also to attend any relevant events and/or use facilities like the Library.

### ARE CLASS TIMES BEING ADJUSTED TO SUPPORT STUDENTS STUDYING OVERSEAS IN OTHER TIMEZONES?

Yes, where possible, Macquarie University and Macquarie University International College (MUIC) are adjusting their timetables to support students to access Live Stream by prioritising live classes to be scheduled in the afternoon AEST.

## HOW DO I ATTEND ORIENTATION AND ENROL IF I AM STUDYING ONLINE?

The proposed orientation date for S3 (November) 2020 and MUIC T6 2020 is scheduled to be on the 26th November 2020 – this will be confirmed closer to commencement date.

You will attend Orientation sessions virtually and enrol in your units online prior to class commencement. You will be notified regarding the process closer to the respective commencement dates.

#### WHAT WILL THE FEES BE FOR ONLINE STUDY?

The fees are the same as face-to-face on-campus study and are listed on the website.

Significant investment has been made in providing a quality online experience. If you are eligible for a scholarship (applicable for online study), it will be applied to your fees.

# Frequently asked questions (continued)

### WHAT WILL THE COMMENCEMENT FEE BE FOR ONLINE STUDY?

Students will be required to pay 2 units equivalent of their enrolment load as part of their commencement fee for UG and PG and to pay for 4 units equivalent for MUIC courses.

NOTE: If students have been offered and accepted a scholarship then this will be factored in as part of their commencement fee. Please check the offer letter for the final amount that needs to be paid.

### IF I COMMENCE MY STUDIES IN NOVEMBER 2020 AND THEN WITHDRAW, WILL I BE ENTITLED TO A REFUND?

If you commence your studies offshore and withdraw PRIOR TO CENSUS DATE for your first Session / Term, you will be entitled to a full refund of your tuition fees.

- S3 2020 (Faculty-taught units) 14th December 2020
- T6 2020 (MUIC-taught units) 15th December 2020

#### WHEN SHOULD I APPLY FOR MY STUDENT VISA?

Our Admissions team will issue a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) as soon as Payment and Acceptance documentations have been received.

We would encourage all international students to apply for their Student Visa as soon as they receive their CoE, even though they may not be able to travel to Australia until a later time during their studies

## WILL STUDYING PART OF A DEGREE ONLINE / OFFSHORE IMPACT REQUIREMENTS FOR THE POST STUDY-WORK VISA?

The Australian Government has recently advised that study completed Online Offshore will count towards the requirements for a Post Study Work Visa for existing and new student visa holders.

As such, we would encourage all international students to apply for their Student Visa as soon as they receive their CoE, even though they may not be able to travel to Australia until a later time during their studies.
